GUIDE TO BEER GLASSWARE



1. FOOTED PILSNER

May have a longer stem. Suitable for German and Czech/Bohemian Pilsners.

2. MASS

Liter-sized glass associated with beer gardens and Oktoberfest. Can be used for any lager less than 6% abv.

3. WEIZEN VASE

Accommodates half liter of beer plus sizeable head. Curvier versions seen.

4. STANGE

Used to serve Kölsch, often in 0.2 liter size.

5. WILLI BECHER

Classic shape suitable for all European lagers.

6. PUB MUG

The dimple mug has a slight retro feel. Used for any classic British or Irish ale.

7. NONIC PINT

Every day pub glass suited to any British or Irish ale.

8. TULIP PINT

Commonly associated with Irish stout but may be used for any British or Irish ale.

9. GOBLET

This and heavier chalice shape used for some Trappist & Abbey ales and some Belgian pale ales.

10. TULIP

Good utility glass suited to many Belgian styles from saison to quad.

11. FRENCH JELLY GLASS

Associated with Witbier but similar shapes used for lambics, Flanders Red, etc.

12. SNIFTER

Smaller glass for higher alcohol beers across all cultures: barley-wines, eisbocks, quads, barrel-aged beers, etc.

13. SHAKER GLASS

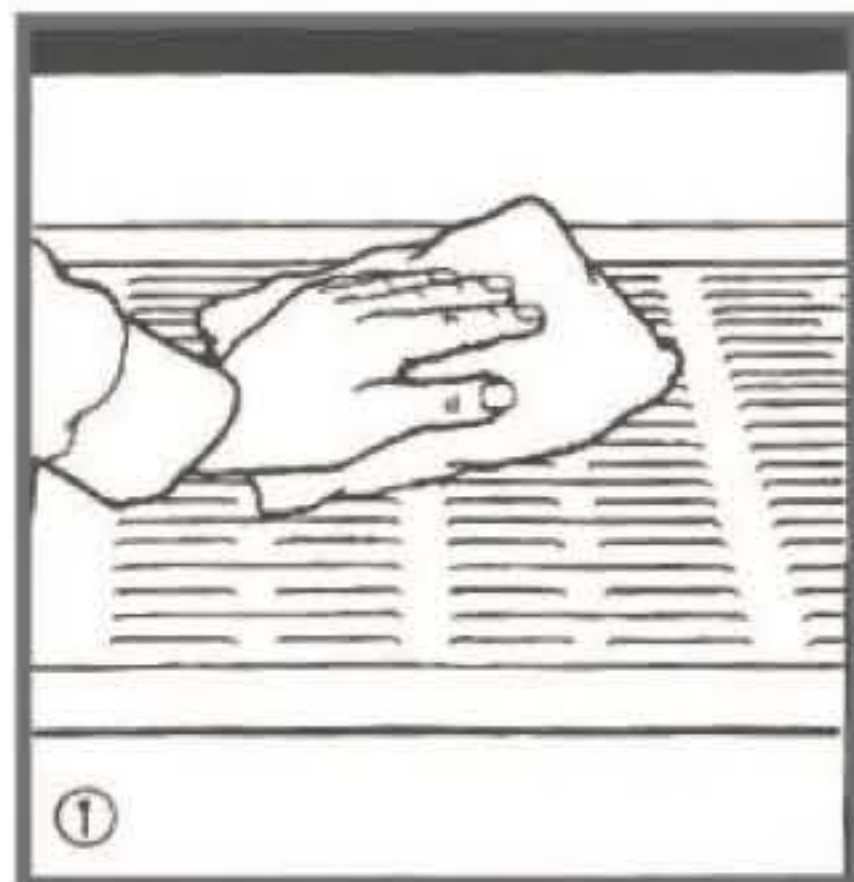
American cocktail shaker adapted for beer. Can be used for any American style of a reasonable alcohol content.

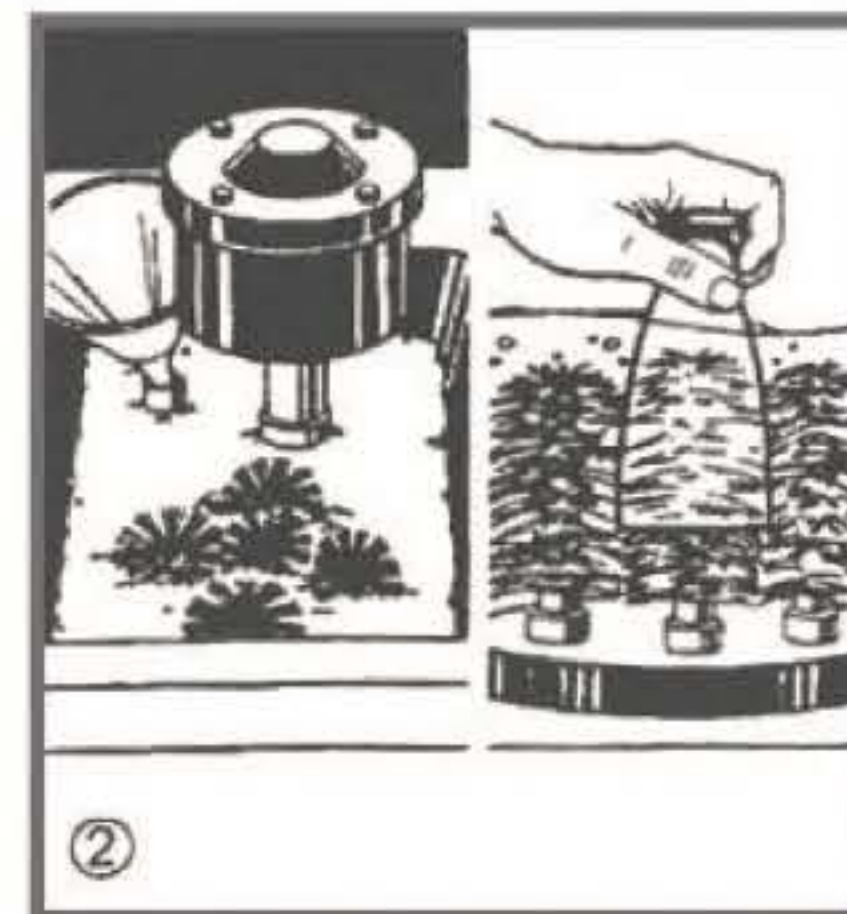

5 STEPS TO CLEANING YOUR GLASSWARE



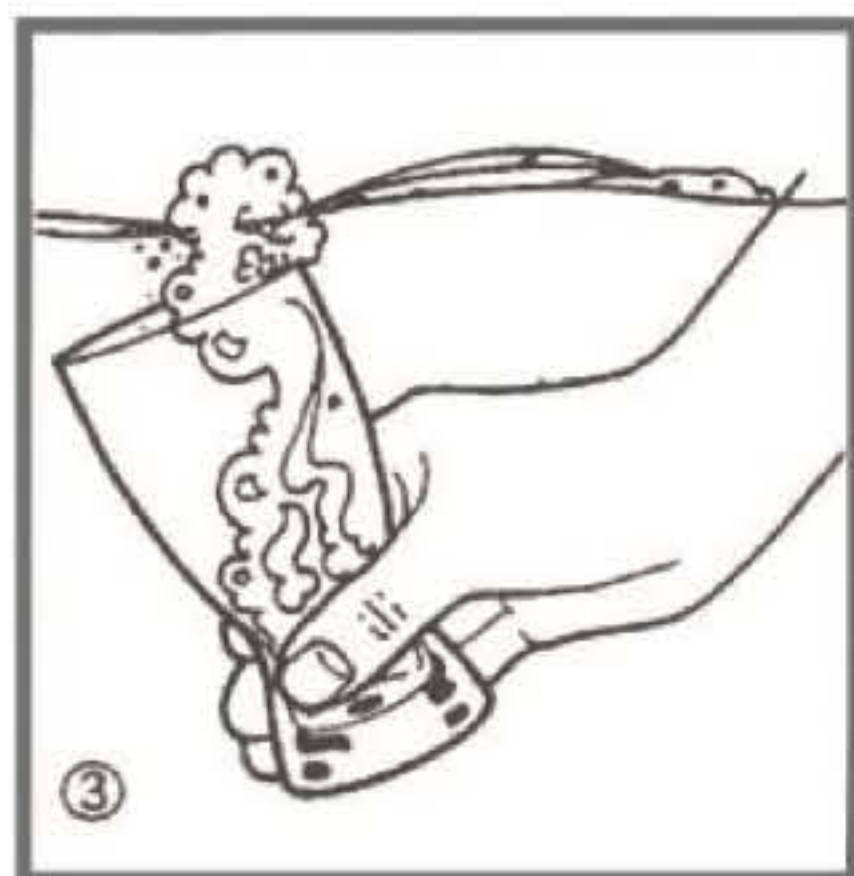
Step 1

All sinks should be thoroughly cleaned prior to washing glasses



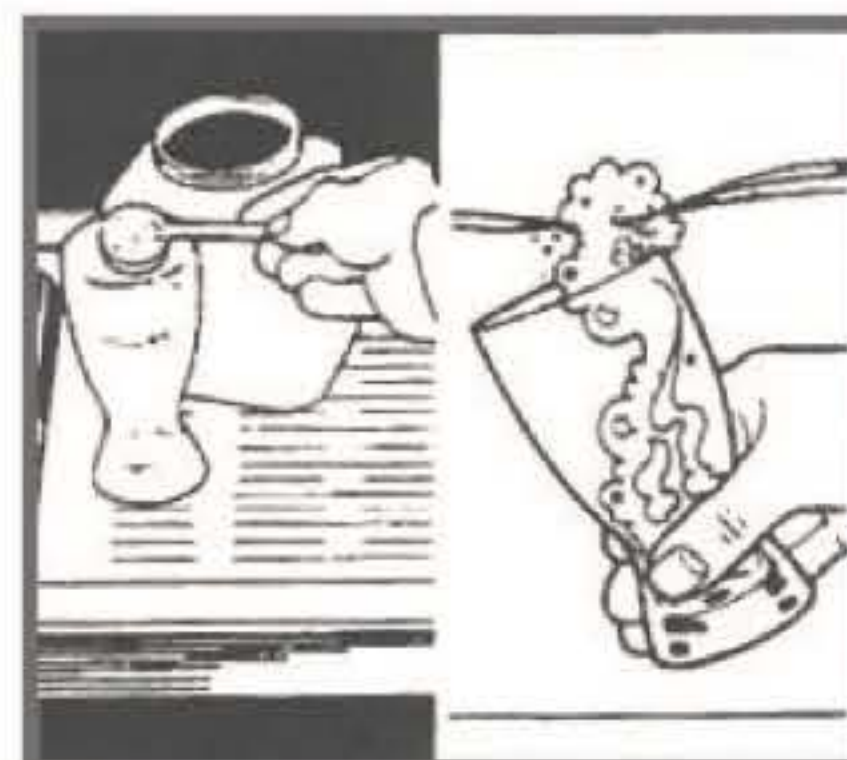
Step 2

Sink 1 — Pour any drink residue into a funnel inserted into the overflow tube. Wash the glass in hot water and low suds, non-oil based detergent using cleaning brushes. Scrub the glass with the cleaning brushes to remove film, lipstick and other residue. Rotate the glass on the brushes to scrub all interior and exterior surfaces.



Step 3

Sink 2 — Rinse the glass, butt down, in cold running water.



Step 4

Sink 3 — Rinse the glass, butt down, in warm water and measured amount of Sanitizer.



Step 5

Air dry the clean glass on a corrugated drain board. Towels impart odors and lint, and also may be washed in petroleum detergents.
